ARRIVAL TO PULA

BY PLANE PULA HAS ITS OWN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT with daily flights to Zagreb

and direct services from many European cities during summer season. It is possible to consider Rijeka Airport on the island of Krk or Trieste Airport (Italy), both approximately 2-hour drive from Pula. Furthermore, the Venice (Italy) and Ljubljana (Slovenia) airports are approximately 3-hour drive from Pula.

Bus station is on the edge of the 'old town' district and it is the hub of local,

domestic and international bus routes.

BY SEA Venezia Lines ferry connects Pula with Venice, most frequently during summer.

ACCOMMODATION IN PULA


A STUDENT DORMITORY

New Student Dormitory is opened and the places offered to incoming students are available but with limited capacities.

PRIVATE ACCOMMODATION

There are more types of private accommodation so they vary by the price and the conditions.

Monthly rent varies depending on location, size and equipment. The average cost is 200 to 400 € for one room or two room apartment with living room (the specified price does not cover overhead expenses). Payment is usually expected at the beginning of the month, while some landlords request payment minimum one month in advance.




LIVING EXPENSES IN PULA

The Croatian Currency is the KUNA, which is divided into 100 lipas.

When listed as a price, the kuna is abbreviated to Kn or HRK.

Foreign currency can be exchanged in banks, currency exchange offices, post offices or at some hotels' reception desks. Living expenses can vary greatly, but as a general overview some are listed in table ahead.

Dormitory price	120 euro/month
Private accommodation (vary in size)	200-400 euro/month
Food	150 euro/month
Local transportation (bus)	30 euro/month
Books	Library available
Miscellaneous	150 euro/month



NOMINATION AND APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. NOMINATION

Coordinator of home University should send an email nomination to <u>international.office@unipu.hr</u>. Nomination includes the following data:

- student's full name
- e-mail address
- semester of planned mobility
- study field
- current study level.

The Office for Partnership and Projects will send the decision about acceptance of the nominated student 4 weeks after the nomination deadline closure.

NOMINATION DEADLINE

For winter semester - June 1st

For summer semester - November 20th



2. APPLICATION

Student is required to send following documents according to the instruction received by email to Office for Partnership and Projects:

- Erasmus Student Application form to the Office for Partnership and Projects.
- Learning Agreement to ECTS (academic) coordinator.

The University of Pula requires that the student has sufficient language skills (in reading, writing and speaking) equivalent to level B2 on the CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) scale. Language proficiency test can be performed upon student arrival to Pula.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

For winter semester – July 1st
For summer semester – December 20th

3. REGISTRATION UPON ARRIVAL

The Office provides support for the administrative procedure upon arrival. Most important steps are:

- Personal identification number acquired through Tax Administration Office.
- Residence permit registration at the Police Department.
- Student x-Card acquired at Student office at the University.

ORIENTATION DAY FOR INCOMING STUDENTS

Exchange students begin the semester at the University with an Orientation Day!

During the Orientation day, the students receive all necessary information's concerning studies and living in Pula. The attendance is compulsory for students. It is usually scheduled throughout second week or semester beginning. For winter semester it is the second week in October and for spring semester second week in March.

INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY CONTACTS


The main role of University is to encourage the mobility of students and employees.
