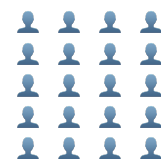

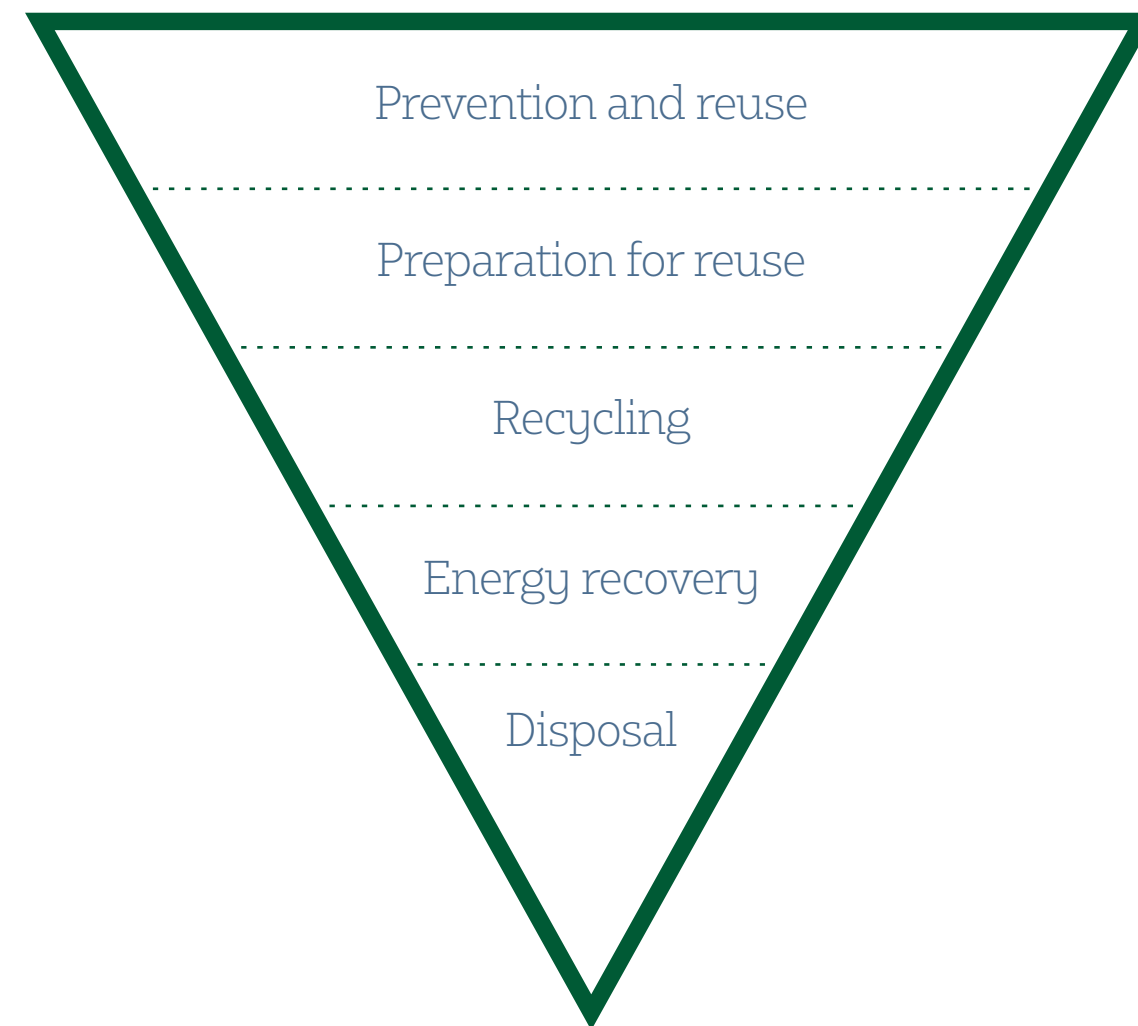

FACTS!



Did you know?
For 1 ton of paper you need to cut down 24 trees!

Compared to ordinary paper production, recycling reduces water pollution by 35% and air pollution by 74%.
A sheet of paper can be recycled four to six times before it completely fall apart.



Did you know?
Glass can be recycled endlessly!

By recycling glass, we save natural raw materials! By using a ton of old glass, we saved 700 kg of sand, 200 kg of calcite, 200 kg of soda, and even 30 tons of oil!!
Glass can be endlessly recycled and reused!



Did you know?
Plastic can be used for garments in the fashion industry!

By recycling plastic, we preserve and protect natural raw materials (oil, natural gas) that are used in its production. Aluminum and steel do not lose their characteristic properties by recycling, and their recycling saves valuable natural raw materials.



Did you know?
The average citizen produces around 386 kg of garbage in a year!

Only non-recyclable raw materials should be disposed of in the general waste. Anyhow, proper separation of raw materials and recycling reduces the amount of non-classified waste.

TEXTILE WASTE

Most textile waste comes from households, but textile waste also occurs in the processes of factory production of fibers and clothing.

Both have great potential for reuse or recycling.

Recycling clothing, footwear and other textiles is simpler and more affordable because textile containers are available in stores.

Textile waste can now be handed over to any textile store larger than 400 m².



HOW TO RECYCLE TEXTILES?

1.

Clothing, footwear, and other textile items that are no longer usable must be separated for recycling and placed in a closed plastic bag.

2.

Textiles should be disposed of in designated containers on the nearest green island or handed over to a recycling yard or store.

Do not store wet and moldy clothes and shoes in the container!





BATTERIES AND ACCUMULATORS

It can be disposed for free in a recycling yard.

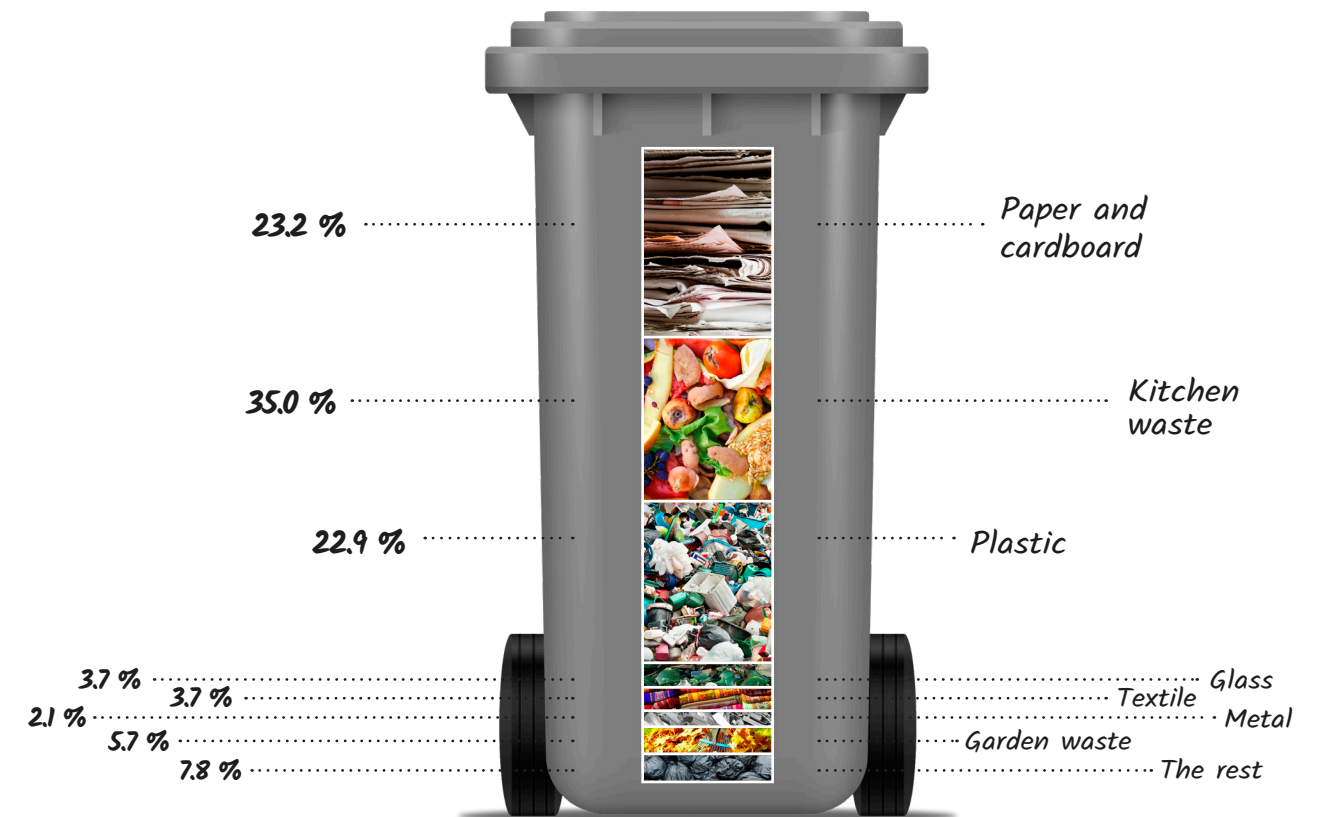
It can be handed over to a service technician for free when repairing a device that contains a portable battery or accumulator.

It can be delivered for free at a store that sells batteries and accumulators.

Batteries can also be disposed of in containers located in many frequent locations.
