 Here, Vladimir Unkovski-Korica re-assesses the key episodes of Tito's rule from the joint Stalin-Tito offensive of 1944, through to the Tito-Stalin split of 1948, the market reforms of the 1950s and the 'turn to the West' which led to Yugoslavia's non-alignment policy. (Read More)

 A concise and accessible introduction to the gender histories of eastern Europe and the Soviet Union in the twentieth century.
